

"Sin No More" By Jesus.

Jesus Statement 1

John 8:11"No, Lord," she said. And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go and sin no more."

Jesus Statement 2

John 5:14 "Afterward Jesus found him in the temple and said to him, "See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse may happen to you."

Jesus made these similar statements to two different people during His life on earth. However careful examination of the statements and the circumstances will help us get Jesus's intentions in each of these cases.

First, reading those two verses again, you can observe that the only words they actually have in common are three "SIN NO MORE" Every other part of the sentences is different.

The background:

Let's start with the man in John 5:1 - 15. He was a disabled man, who was in his condition for 38 years. Now, we don't know about the cause of this man's condition, but it was not from birth. But Jesus's statement and warning to him later "Sin no more that something worse do not happen to you" showed there was a connection between the man's disability and his sins. His disability must have been caused by his sins.

The woman (John 8:3-11) on the other hand, encountered Jesus on the account of her sin. She just nearly escaped being stoned to death by the keepers of Mosaic laws. And then after they all saw clearly that they were all guilty of sin, they all left. And Jesus told the woman something profound "I DO NOT CONDEMN YOU. GO AND SIN NO MORE"

Now, let us examine the differences between these two cases.

The difference #1 - The Danger of Physical Need-Based and Prosperity Gospel

The man in John 5 had no encounter with Christ about his sins forgiveness. He only encountered Christ by receiving a healing miracle from Him. There was no sin forgiveness. There was no change of heart, but physical change in condition.

This is similar to many people whose story of coming to Christ is all about God doing some miracles for them. It was not about Jesus saving them from their sins. They were probably promised a better job, a more stable health and living condition and that was why they became a Christian or they think they become one.

On the other hand, the woman in John 8 encountered Jesus not to have a better life but to have a life. Her life from that moment on was a GIFT from Jesus, because she would have long gone, if not that she was brought to Jesus. And beyond that, Jesus gave her not just her life, but ETERNAL LIFE - the Gift of no condemnation.

LESSON 1: DON'T SEEK GOD FOR A BETTER LIFE, BUT FOR ETERNAL LIFE. Jesus's primary purpose is not to give us bread, but to be unto us "THE BREAD OF LIFE".

Note this: ETERNAL LIFE SUPERSEDES LONG LIFE AND BETTER LIFE. Don't accept Christ because of better life and long life. Accept Him because of Eternal Life.

Lesson 2: Don't preach a physical need-based message about Jesus, that focuses on physical need of the people.

Preach about Jesus meeting their Spiritual and Eternal need. People can meet their physical needs through other means. People can even meet their moral needs through various programs. BUT NO MAN CAN HAVE THEIR SINS FORGIVEN WITHOUT THE DEATH AND RESSURECTION OF JESUS. So, preach forgiveness in the name of Jesus. That is what the Apostles preached. That is our message.

Don't preach Jesus, the miracle worker or a great teacher, preach Jesus the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Don't end up producing "the man of John 5" as your convert, instead of the woman of John 8, the woman who was truly forgiven of her sins. Focus on what matters. other things fall in shape in time.

Mathew 6:33 "Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness. All other things shall be added unto you"

The Difference #2.: CHRIST'S FORGIVENESS IS ETERNAL AND IRREVOCABLE.

The woman received the IRREVOCABLE GIFT OF NO CONDEMNATION from Christ - the Gift of Forgiveness. Do you note clearly that the woman was NOT given an alternative. Unlike the man, the woman was NOT told by Jesus "Sin no more or something worse will happen to you". This was NOT a mistake.

It is simply because "The Gift and Callings of God are Irrevocable". She was not and would not be condemned by Christ - Final. There can be no condemnation for those freely justified by Christ.

For her, it was an issue of TOTAL FORGIVENESS. No one could ever bring any charge against her. GOD HAS JUSTIFIED HER AND SHE WAS FOREVER JUSTIFIED.

Lesson 3: God's forgiveness is TOTAL. If you have truly found refuge in Christ, like this woman, ALL your sins have been forgiven IN CHRIST.

You live above condemnation. Jesus said this concerning those of us who fled to Him for refuge.

John 5:24

""I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life."
(NLT)

"Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life." (ESV)

Also, Hebrews 7:25

"Therefore he is able, **once and forever, to save** those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf."

Romans 8:31-34

- "31. What then shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?
- 32.He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, freely give us all things?
- 33. Who will bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.
- **34.**Who is there to condemn us? For Christ Jesus, who died, and more than that was raised to life, is at the right hand of God—and He is interceding for us."

Difference #3.: GRACE EMPOWERS, NOT PUNISHES.

The woman was LAUNCHED FORTH / EMPOWERED BY GRACE.

Note that Jesus did not tell her to sin no more, unlike the other man. Jesus told her "GO AND SIN NO MORE"..

That word **GO** makes a lot of difference. IT IS AN EMPOWERMENT TO LIVE ABOVE SINFUL LIFESTYLE.

Jesus was NOT giving her a warning. Rather she was empowered by Jesus to live above the power of sin.

The other man was WARNED by Jesus "If you sin, you will bring worse things upon yourself."

This is what many of our pastors are preaching, instead of preaching "EMPOWERMENT OVER SIN", they are preaching repercussions of sins, as if Jesus has not died to pay for those things.

NOTE: that Jesus only preached this to the unconverted, un-regenerated man, but for the woman who has been forgiven in Christ, Jesus empowered her to sin no more.

Lesson 4: If you are God's Son and you have received the Gift of Christ's Total Forgiveness by putting your faith in His death, then YOU CAN ONLY BE EMPOWERED TO LIVE ABOVE SIN. God is no longer counting your sins against you.

2 Corinthians 5:19.

"that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation."

Romans 4:8

"Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against them."

You are that man. I am that man. Unto who the Lord no longer counts sins against. IN HIM WE HAVE NO SIN, FOR JESUS HAS BEEN MADE SIN FOR US.

1 John 3:5

"But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And in him is no sin."

Glory!!! That is the blessing of those IN CHRIST.

Difference #4: Law Actually Leads to More Sin.

IMMEDIATELY, after Jesus gave this unsaved man a warning to stop sinning or else something worse will happen to him, **the man immediately went out and sinned**. Wooooooow.

He went out to inform the Pharisees who were looking for the person that healed him for punishment, that it was Jesus who healed him, despite the fact that they told him how furious they were at whoever told him to take up his bed on the Sabbath day.

The man did something very similar to what Judas did- he betrayed Jesus. And that happened IMMEDIATELY after Jesus warned him of consequences of his sinning.

Lesson 5: Law actually awakes the consciousness of sin and makes people sins more.

People don't stop sinning because they are told of the consequence. They actually sin more. Don't be deceived that by reading the law, you can keep the law. You are actually empowering sin in your life.

"1 Corinthians 15: 56 - 57

"The sting of death is sin, and the **power of sin is the Law**. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ"

Did you just read that? THE POWER OF SIN IS THE LAW. Sin feeds on the law. Law empowers sin.

Stop focusing on the law of sin and death. Focus on the law of Spirit of LIFE IN CHRIST JESUS.. Pastors, stop preaching law and sins. Stop killing your members. Focus on Christ and His victory on the cross over sin.

I once put up a status that "If you hear me mention sin, I mean forgiveness of sin, and the finished works of Christ over sins"

In Christ is our victory. Sons of God, you have been empowered to live above sin. You are ETERNALLY above condemnation. For you, it is "You are not condemned. Go and sin no more and that is it. No condemnation. NOT NOW, NOT EVER."

Do not live your life with the fear of fall. Live in the Victory of the Blood of Christ. Isn't it soooooo sweet to be IN CHRIST?

Glorrrry to Jesus. Leave me a comment. I love you eternally in Christ. We win always in Him. Pray through this message, and then go for the next power message.

SHALL WE CONTINUE IN SIN, THAT GRACE MAY ABOUND?

(UNDERSTANDING YOUR SPIRITUAL LOCATION AS A BELIEVER)

Exegesis on Romans 6:1 - 2

"What shall we say then? Are we to continue IN SIN that grace may abound? By no means! How CAN WE who died to sin still LIVE IN IT?"

First let me call your attention to the fact that this verse is about Believer's Location Or Address.

Can a TRUE believer continue IN SIN? May be the preceding question is "Is a true believer located IN SIN?" BECAUSE YOU CANNOT continue IN A PLACE YOU ARE NOT LOCATED AT.

So, what does the Bible say about Believer's location?

Where were we before being born again and where are we now as Believers? That is the key to understanding Romans 6:1-2. Read the verses below:

Psalm 51:5

"Behold, I was brought forth IN INIQUITY, and IN SIN did my mother conceive me"

Ephesians 2:1-2a

"And you WERE dead IN THE TRESPASSES AND SINS, IN WHICH you USED to live..."

Colossians 1:13

"For HE has rescued us FROM THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS and brought us INTO THE KINGDOM OF BELOVED SON"

So, as you can see from the verses above, before Salvation, **we were IN SIN**. Everybody was conceived and born IN SIN. We were Spiritually located IN SIN. Colossians called it the DOMAIN OF DARKNESS. Even the best moralist in the world, is spiritually located IN SIN - THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS.

But what happened when we became children of God?

There was a TRANSLATION - or a transfer that took place. From

Colossians 1:13

"For HE has rescued us FROM THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS and brought us INTO THE KINGDOM OF BELOVED SON"

We were transferred INTO THE KINGDOM OF HIS BELOVED SON - IN CHRIST.

So, every believer is now in a different location from where we USED to be.

Our PRESENT (new) Spiritual location is called IN CHRIST.

See that in 2 Corinthians 5: 17,21:

"Therefore, if anyone is IN CHRIST, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.... For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that IN HIM we might become the righteousness of God."

It is very important we understand this principle of Our Spiritual location, in order to manifest the qualities of where we are - **IN CHRIST.**

1 Corinthians 1: 30

"But of him ARE YOU **IN CHRIST JESUS**, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption"

Romans 12:5

"So we, being many, are **ONE BODY IN CHRIST**, and every one members one of another."

1 Corinthians 1:2

"Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are **sanctified IN CHRIST JESUS**, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours"

1 Corinthians 15:22

"For as in Adam all die, even so IN CHRIST shall all be made alive"

SO, BELIEVERS ARE LOCATED IN CHRIST, AND THEREFORE CANNOT BE IN SIN AT THE SAME TIME Because according to 1 John 3:5, there is NO SIN IN CHRIST.

1 John 3:5

"But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And IN HIM IS NO SIN."

SO, SINCE WE ARE IN CHRIST AS BELIEVERS, WE CANNOT BE IN SIN, AND THEREFORE CANNOT CONTINUE IN SIN.

So, the question "SHALL WE CONTINUE IN SIN...?

Paul was indirectly saying: "You were in sin before as unbelievers. BUT AS YOU BECAME GOD'S CHILDREN, YOU WERE TRANSLATED INTO A DIFFERENT KINGDOM - IN CHRIST. So, be aware that YOU CANNOT CONTINUE IN SIN/ THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS - YOUR FORMER LOCATION. Wake up to this reality, so you can manifest it out." That is the paraphrase of that verse.

And next verse (vs 2) of Romans 6 said it MORE CLEARLY by asking a question that answers the question in verse 1. Let's read both verses together for CONTEXTUAL MEANING.

Romans 6:1-2

- "1. Shall we continue in sin, that Grace will abound?
- 2. By No Means. HOW CAN WE WHO ARE DEAD TO SIN CONTINUE TO LIVE IN IT?"

Wooooow, can you see this truth clearly reading the 2 verses together..

Again, note the clause "continue to live IN IT" in verse 2

IN ORDER WORDS, WE CANNOT CONTINUE TO LIVE IN SIN, BECAUSE WE ARE NO MORE LOCATED IN SIN, RATHER WE ARE DEAD TO IT.

GOD'S ETERNAL WISDOM AND OPERATION – WE ARE DEAD TO SIN BUT ALIVE IN CHRIST.

God's wisdom to ensure we are relocated from "IN SIN" address was to make us 'DEAD TO SIN" but ALIVE TO CHRIST" That is why we are IN CHRIST - address.

SO THERE IS AN URGENT NEED FOR US GOD'S CHILDREN TO KNOW THIS REALITY OF OUR SPIRITUAL ADDRESS.

WE ARE IN CHRIST

WE ARE IN THE KINGDOM OF LIGHT

WE ARE SEATED WITH HIM IN THE HEAVENLY PLACES

WE ARE NOT IN SIN. WE WERE RESCUED FROM THERE.

WE CANNOT CONTINUE WHERE WE DON'T BELONG.

WE ARE NOT IN DARKNESS. Alleluyah!!!!

Now, Let us Consider 2 Things that ROMANS 6:1-2 DOES NOT MEAN:

1. It does NOT mean, you can EXHAUST GOD'S GRACE BY SINNING. God's Grace is INEXHAUSTIBLE. Remember "HIS MERCIES ARE NEW EVERY MORNING"

Also, Hebrews 4:16 says "LET US COME BOLDLY TO THE THRONE OF GRACE, SO THAT WE MAY RECEIVE MERCY AND FIND GRACE IN OUR TIME OF NEEDS"

You don't need to make an appointment, You don't need to book ahead. GOD'S GRACE IS AVAILABLE 24 HOURS AND IT IS IN ABUNDANCE... That is why it is called ETERNAL LIFE. A life that cannot be exhausted.

So, no matter how many times you have missed it in your actions, GOD'S GRACE IS ABUNDANT FOR YOU. HOWEVER, GOD'S GRACE ALSO HELPS YOU TO BECOME STABLE. IT IS BOTH SIDED.

2. Also, It does NOT mean "a rebranding of sinful acts" It does not mean IF you do something that is not right, then you don't need to rebrand it and call it another name.

Now, Let us consider:

SEVEN BENEFITS OF OUR NEW SPIRITUAL ADDRESS - IN CHRIST:

1. "IN HIM, You have REDEMPTION, THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS"

Colossians 1:14, Ephesians 1:7. So, you already have redemption and YOUR SINS ARE FORGIVEN. That is why I don't need to ask for forgiveness of sins, because I HAVE THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS WHERE I AM LOCATED IN CHRIST... I don't ask for what I already have...

When I show remorse for sins, it is not obtain forgiveness, it is to help me in restoring myself. I HAVE FORGIVENESS OF SINS WHERE I AM - IN CHRIST. Glory!!!!

2. "IN HIM are hidden all the TREASURES OF WISDOM AND KNOWLEDGE"

Colossians 2:3. When you understand your new Spiritual Location - IN CHRIST, You can take advantage of Treasures of Wisdom and Knowledge. God will give you DEEP INSIGHTS into His mysteries. And you will be wise above your teachers. These treasures dwell IN CHRIST.

3. "For IN CHRIST all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form" (Colossians 2:9) In Christ, our new address, there dwell THE FULLNESS OF GOD'S NATURE.

We can enjoy all the fullness of God's nature and His divine power in our present world, because they are located IN CHRIST.

The power of God (The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit) combined all dwell IN CHRIST. We are highly dynamic people, with so much power, ALL WE NEED TO DO, IS TO MANIFEST OUR SONSHIP...

"For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing (manifestation) of the sons of God."

When are we going to be manifesting? When we recognize the DIVINE NATURE/DYNAMO OF GOD IN US.

4. "And YOU ARE COMPLETE IN HIM, who is the head of all principality and power:" Colossians 2:10. Another awesome benefit of being IN CHRIST is SPIRITUAL COMPLETENESS OR PERFECTION...

In Christ, we were made complete, and are perfected forever. (Hebrews 10:14)

Hebrews `10:14

"Because by a single offering **He has made perfect** forever those who are sanctified."

If anyone is asking you to grow into perfection, he does not have an idea of OUR IDENTITIES IN CHRIST... You are already perfected in Christ. We grow inside perfection, not grow into it..

I wrote this previously, SPRITUAL GROWTH IS NOT GROWING INTO PERFECTION. RATHER, GROWING INSIDE PERFECTION, AND MANIFESTING THE PERFECTION IN OUR DAILY LIVES. That is the correct definition of Spiritual Growth.

You are not trying to BECOME better. NO. YOU ARE TRYING TO MANIFEST OR REFLECT "THE PERFECTION OF CHRIST IN YOU OUTSIDE IN YOUR DAILY LIVING... That is what it means to WORK OUT YOUR SALVATION WHICH HAS BEEN WORKED IN YOU BY CHRIST. Philippians 2:12-13.

5 "But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And IN HIM IS NO SIN" 1 John 3:5 As we have been discussing since, IN CHRIST (OUR NEW ADDRESS), THERE IS NO SIN.

This has two benefits,

Number 1, GOD DOES NOT AND CANNOT ASSOCIATE ANY SIN WITH US AS HIS CHILDREN, This means if we commit a sinful act, they are automatically imputed to Jesus, SO, NO SIN CAN BE IMPUTED TO US, BECAUSE WE ARE IN CHRIST. Sin cannot survive IN HIM.

Number 2, IN HIM IS NO SIN, We should renew our mind to this awesome identity we have in CHRIST. IT IS CALLED "NO SIN" I John 3:5, OR "CANNOT SIN" (1 John 3:9) OR "DEAD TO SIN" (Romans 6:2)

We should declare it, confess it, renew our minds with it, THEN, WE WILL EXPERIENCE IT IN THE PHYSICAL... That is why I declare daily "I AM BORN OF GOD, I CANNOT SIN BECAUSE I HAVE HIS SEED / DNA IN ME. I CANNOT SIN, BECAUSE IN CHRIST WHERE I DWELL, THERE IS NO SIN" This should be our daily confessions, until our minds become totally renewed to it, and of course, we will continue to confess and enjoy it. Glory!!!

6. "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that IN HIM we might become the RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

Another benefit of being IN CHRIST is that we HAVE THE RIGHT STANDING WITH GOD. Everyone in Christ is righteous, and more than that we are righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

So, anytime the devil comes to tell you God is not happy, with you, tell Him you are God's righteousness. YOU STAND RIGHT WITH GOD. This will eventual translate to living right.. BUT YOU ARE ALREADY RIGHT WITH GOD. Because you are IN CHRIST.

7. "And you also were included IN CHRIST when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked IN HIM WITH A SEAL, THE PROMISED HOLY SPIRIT," Ephesians 1:13.

The last IN CHRIST benefit we are examining is that WE ARE SEALED WITH HOLY SPIRIT IN HIM. If you are in Christ, you are sealed/ marked with Holy Spirit. This is the seal of Our Sonship, it is the seal that ensures we go with Christ when He comes for His own. THAT IS WHY THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL BE WITH US FOREVER, BECAUSE WE ARE IN CHRIST...

We have no fear of falling away, because we are SEALED in Him with the Holy Spirit. Satan or legalism cannot threaten us or scare us with hell, or any form of punishment.

WE ARE SEALED WITH THE PROMISED HOLY SPIRIT BECAUSE WE ARE IN CHRIST. WE HAVE PASSED FROM DEATH TO LIFE, BECAUSE WE ARE IN CHRIST.

ABOVE ALL, WE ARE SEALED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT OF PROMISE IN CHRIST.

GLORY!!!!! I AM SOOOOOOOO EXCITED IN CHRIST.

WHAT DO YOU PREACH: GOOD NEWS OR OKAY NEWS?

I don't preach an "Okay-news" I preach the Good news (Gospel).

"For I am not ashamed of the Gospel (Good-news), for it is the power of God unto Salvation, for all who believe" Romans 1:16

1. Okay news says "Jesus can save you but you still have to work FOR your Salvation, and pay Jesus back for dying for you...."

The Good-news says "Jesus did ALL for you on the cross and announced "It is finished". Believe and enjoy.".

2. Okay-news says "Jesus has forgiven your past sins, but your present and future sins, you must really beg Him for forgiveness and promise Him not to sin again, or else..."

The Good-news says "ALL your sins have been forgiven IN CHRIST because they were all legally paid for. And He no longer counts sin against you. 2 Corinthians 5:19 So there can be no present of future sin for all those IN CHRIST. "In Him there is no sin" 1 John 3:5 "

3. Okay-news says "You are saved, AS LONG AS YOU DO THIS AND THAT..."

The Good-news says "You are ETERNALLY SAVED IN CHRIST"

4. Okay-news says "GIVE your life to Jesus..."

The Good-news says "RECEIVE Jesus into your life. Receive His forgiveness"

5. Okay-news says "Hold very tight unto the Lord, so you don't fall away from Him... This Christian life is so delicate o. We must be on fireeee for the Lord"

The Good-news says "The Lord is holding unto His sheep, and He said particularly that NO ONE can snatch us from His hands. We are eternally safe and secured in Him"

6. Okay news is NOT THE Gospel. It is NOT the power of God, it is rather the power of religion. It can NOT save anyone.

Only the Good-news of Our Lord Jesus saves and delivers. Our message is clear - no compromise. JESUS PLUS NOTHING, MINUS NOTHING.

Preach ONLY the Good-news of Jesus!!!
